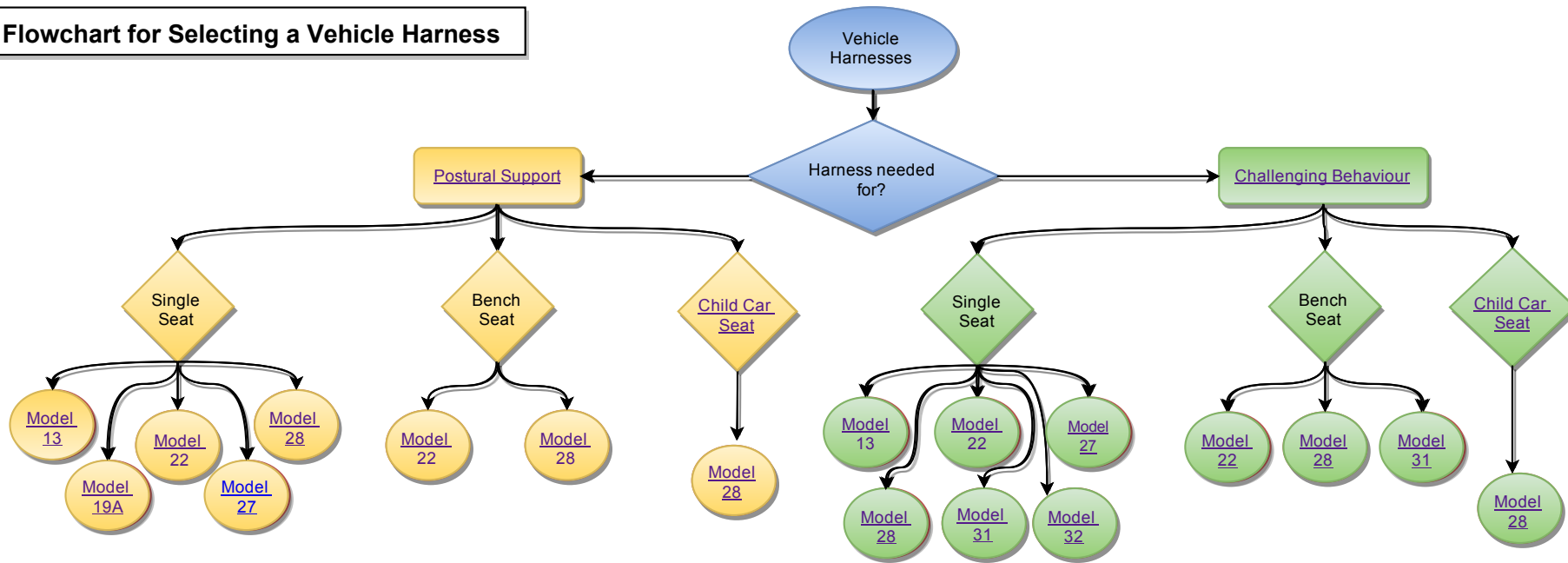


## Flowchart for Selecting a Vehicle Harness

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Fully <b>rear fastening</b> harness complete with chest pad</li> <li>Easy access is required behind the seat back &amp; underneath the base of the seat. e.g. people carriers, mini buses or front passenger seat</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Front fastening harness</li> <li>Consists of waist belt and shoulder straps</li> <li>The Understrap is optional</li> <li>Waist belt is fitted with a Press Release buckle</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Full 5 point harness with chest pad.</li> <li>Body harness is fitted to the passenger "before" entering the vehicle.</li> <li>Additional Fixings Straps can be purchased for passengers travelling in more than one vehicle</li> </ul>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Full supportive, 5 point, front fastening harness.</li> <li>Fits to the seat with two <b>Horizontal Fixing Straps</b>.</li> <li><b>Fits single seats, Aircraft seats &amp; other types of single seating</b></li> <li>Available with the Steel Safety Buckle for those passengers who will undo the Press Release Buckle - see <a href="#">Model 27 Steel</a></li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Full supportive, 5 point, front fastening harness.</li> <li>Fits to the seat with two <b>Vertical Fixing Straps</b>.</li> <li><b>Will fit some Group 2-3 child seats</b></li> <li>Available with the Steel Safety Buckle for those passengers who will undo the Press Release Buckle - see <a href="#">Model 28 Steel</a></li> <li>For those seats where the back rest narrows the <a href="#">Model 27</a> is more suitable</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Front fastening harness for escapologists &amp; challenging behaviour</li> <li>Fits to the seat with two <b>Vertical Fixing Straps</b></li> <li>For those seats where the back rest narrows the <a href="#">Model 32</a> is more suitable</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Front fastening harness for escapologists &amp; challenging behaviour</li> <li>Fits to the seat with two <b>Horizontal Fixing Straps</b>.</li> </ul>
