This Month We Have...

Baby Room- The babies have been exploring lots outside in the beautiful sunshine, splashing in water to cool them off and learning a lot of new words! The babies have enjoyed singing songs ad showing off their WIGGLES. Lots of physical skills have been developing, walking, crawling, and pulling to standing. The babies have enjoyed exploring paint using different mark making tools, including their hands! A surprise visit from a fire engine was very exciting.

Middlies room- The children have been exploring outside developing their physical skills, singing lots of nursery rhymes and dancing. The children have also enjoyed exploring paint, paint pens and coloured water. We have been doing lots of number songs encouraging counting, songs such as five little ducks, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 once I caught a fish alive. The children enjoyed exploring in the fire engine and painting red pictures.

Transition Room- The children have enjoyed exploring the paint using the cars, making different paint tracks. They have also had a lot of outdoor play, exploring for bugs, developing their physical skills using the scooters and balance bikes, and developing their friendships by working together. A fire engine came to visit, and the children got to explore inside of it. They have been using lots of mathematical language and enjoyed measuring themselves.

Preschool Room- The preschool children have been super busy this month, we have been concentrating lots on rhyming words, such as hat, cat, bat, mat. The children have also been taking it in turns to use their imagination to create our own Preschool Story.

Continuing their imagination, the children have LOVED the role play area playing cats and dogs, mummies, and daddies. We had a surprise visit from a fire engine and the children got to explore inside it and asked tonnes of questions to the firemen.... They even got to use a hosepipe! The children have enjoyed playing outside in all weather's, we got SOAKED one day from the rain, but it helped us to clean the toys.
