This Month We Have...

Baby Room- We have been focusing on our physical skills lots this month, using the baby walkers and physical gym. We have been encouraging the babies to walk outside holding one hand. They have been doing a fantastic job! The babies have also been exploring LOTS of messy and edible malleable resources such as spaghetti hoops and yoghurt paint. We have been singing rhymes and looking at books to encourage communication skills, the babies have been learning many new words and sounds.

Middlies room- The middlies have been focusing on self-regulation in our new calm zone. Lots of story books about emotions, sensory toys and calming music throughout the day to encourage a more quiet, calm, positive and secure environment. The middles have been exploring the outdoor environment more now the weather is getting nicer. Lots of water/sand play has been enhancing the middlies language skills.

Transition Room- The children have been working hard on their manners this month, staff have been modeling lots of positive language such as please and thank you, positive body language and listening to each other/ the children. We have also been encouraging more independence with the children, putting their own coats on, getting their own lunch bags and finding their peg. The children have enjoyed exploring the outdoor environment a lot more as the weather is getting nicer.

Preschool Rom- The preschoolers have been focusing on creating a more calm, quiet, and positive environment. We have been exploring the new areas in the room.. the role play has been a BIG hit! We have been learning about how to care for living things, life cycles and the food chain through our fact books and 'Google' The children have enjoyed exploring in the orchard looking for insects and CREEPY CRAWLIES! We have been playing lots of group games outside developing our PSE skills such as scarecrow tig, golden bridge and hide and seek. We have been looking at shapes around the environment too.
