Day Service Social Care Worker

We provide day opportunities to help prevent social isolation and improve the quality of life for older people living with Dementia and long-term health issues, enabling members to live well in their own homes for as long as possible.

Our Day Service offers a comfortable, welcoming environment for members to enjoy the company of others, to maintain skills and encourage community integration. We promote good conversations and member participation which allows us to offer a range of activities to meet our members emotional, mental, and physical needs.

Job Title: Day Service Social Care Worker

<u>Part Time Post – 16 hours per week worked over two days (Thursday/Friday)</u>

Responsible To: Manager

Aims of the Post: Provide person-centred (outcome focused) care and support for Caring in Craigmillar Members, we support members living with long term health issues and members with a diagnosis of dementia; we aim to prevent or delay the need for full time care and aim to assist our members to live as independently as possible; And to effectively implement all Caring in Craigmillar's policies, procedures, and guidelines.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE POST:

- Following Caring in Craigmillar's Health & Safety Policy and Working Practice Guidelines to ensure the safety and wellbeing of members.
- Working in line with the Health and Social Care Standards.
- Working in line with the Scottish Social Services Codes of Practice.
- Carrying out escort duties as designated by line manager. This includes ensuring all members are supported in a safe and professional manner and following all applicable Risk Assessments.
- Providing effective person-centred support (outcome focused) day care to members to enable them to choose and participate fully in the activities offered / available.
- Attending sensitively to the personal care needs of members.
- Working alongside team members in a supportive and enabling manner.

- Actively listening to the needs of members and relaying any relevant information to line management in a timely fashion.
- Communicating relevant information to carers / other agencies / relevant bodies, in strict consultation with line management, and respecting confidentiality.
- Contributing ideas to the ongoing development of the Service.
- Completing of all associated day care / care plan documentation in a timely and professional manner.
- Completion of various domestic tasks as directed by line management.
- Attending and participating in all staff meetings and carrying out any specific actions identified.
- Be a designated Key Worker to named individuals, with additional responsibility for carrying out this additional role.
- Be aware of Health and Safety responsibilities towards the wider public when carrying out your duties.
- Other duties assigned by line management, which reasonably fall within the scope of this post.

PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT:

- Participate in Support and Supervision sessions with the Manager, or designated line manager.
- Participate in identifying training and development needs.
- Attend relevant training courses and in-service training, in consultation with the Manager and subject to budgetary constraints.

SKILLS AND EXPERIENCE:

- SVQ Level 2 Award in Health and Social Care is preferred, but not necessary.
- An ability to demonstrate a clear understanding of person-centred care and the challenges facing people living with dementia and long-term health issues.
- Awareness of and ability to work with people who may exhibit challenging behaviour.
- Ability to work on own initiative.
- Ability to work effectively alongside volunteers and trainees in a supportive and enabling manner.
- Ability to communicate well with a diverse range of contacts and present a positive public image for the Organisation.
- To work in a professional manner and to support Caring in Craigmillar.
