- 2. Ensure all necessary measures are taken to reduce any risks found as a result of any assessments.
- 3. Ensure all equipment used is regularly checked and is suitable for its purpose, is in good working order, and free from defect.
- 4. Ensure all equipment is obtained from reputable suppliers and manufacturers and conforms to the relevant British and European Standards.
- 5. Safe use/guidance information for using waterfed poles/ladders are contained on our website.
- 6. Ensure all equipment is stored correctly, never left unattended and is returned to the company vehicle after use.
- 7. As a member of the Federation of Window Cleaners, County Window Cleaners receive updates highlighting any new guidance/regulations which ensure that policies are kept up to date.
