Training is undertaken as and when required to ensure every window cleaning task is completed safely and efficiently. Health and Safety information is reviewed periodically or if there are changes in equipment or legislation.

Arrangements for Securing the Health and Safety of Myself/Clients

County window Cleaners will:

1. Carry out Risk Assessments and Method Statements for our commercial customers, periodically monitoring and reviewing all work activities involving window cleaning.
2. Ensure all necessary measures are taken to reduce any risks found as a result of any assessments.
3. Ensure all equipment used is regularly checked and is suitable for its purpose, is in good working order, and free from defect.
4. Ensure all equipment is obtained from reputable suppliers and manufacturers and conforms to the relevant British and European Standards.
5. Safe use/guidance information for using waterfed poles/ladders are contained on our website.
6. Ensure all equipment is stored correctly, never left unattended and is returned to the company vehicle after use.
7. As a member of the Federation of Window Cleaners, County Window Cleaners receive monthly updates highlighting any new guidance/regulations which ensures that policies are kept up to date.
