Early Advisory - Fee Increase April 1st 2020

Due to the lack of funding from the Government, increases in wages, pensions and utilities, as well as resources & equipment - we have no choice but to raise our hourly fees as from 1st April 2020.

Increases are as follows - Under 2's = £5.00 ph - 2 - 3 yrs = £4.60 ph - Over 3 yrs = £4.50 ph
(all of the above hourly rates are in line with other local nurseries)

We will also be raising the cost of our Afternoon Tea's to £2.00
