

Standard Price List

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary).

ATTENDED FUNERAL (funeral director's charges only)	Total £ 1795
This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.	
Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements.	£870
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within) 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care.	£125
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at Mark FH Rae's funeral homes	£200
Providing a suitable coffin — this will be made from Standard Oak Veneered Coffin	£350
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the customer).	£50
At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle.	£200
UNATTENDED FUNERAL	
This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.	
Burial (funeral director's charges only)	£800
Cremation (funeral director's charges plus the cremation fee)²	£1585
FEES YOU MUST (on top)	
For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the burial fee is: ¹ In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee is:	£520-£850
For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.	
For an Attended cremation funeral, the cremation fee. ² In this local area, the typical cost of a cremation is:	£770 - £1155 £800

ADDITIONAL FUNERAL DIRECTOR PRODUCTS AND SERVICES	
This funeral director can supply a range of optional, additional products and services, or to arrange (on your behalf) for a third party to supply them. Examples include:	
Additional mileage (price per mile outside Lancashire Region).	£1.40
Additional transfers of the deceased person's body (e.g. to their home, to a place of worship)	£120
Collection and delivery of ashes.	Free of Charge
Embalming .	£80 - £ 130
Funeral officiant (e.g. celebrant, minister of religion etc.) Prices on request	£199-£225
Services supplied outside of normal office hours.	
Limousine	£140 (each)
The funeral director can give you a list of what they supply, this includes; press notices, floral tributes, order of services, streaming, supplying of music.	

¹ This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

² In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.
