## Standardised price list

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary).

<b>ATTENDED FUNERAL – Funeral director's charges only</b>	
This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.	<b>£2395</b>
Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements	<b>£700</b>
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care.	<b>£300</b>
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at the funeral director's branch premises	<b>£425</b>
Providing a simple foil coffin, suitable for cremation	<b>From £445</b>
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the customer out of office hours)	<b>(£25 out of office hours only)</b>
At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) in an appropriate vehicle.	<b>£500</b>

<b>UNATTENDED FUNERAL</b>	
This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the cremation itself.	
Burial (funeral director's charges only)	<b>£1700</b>
Cremation (funeral director's charges plus the cremation fee) <sup>2</sup>	<b>£1995</b>

<b>FEES YOU MUST PAY</b>	
For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the <b>burial fee</b> . <sup>1</sup> In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is: <i>For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.</i>	<b>£1200</b>
For an Attended cremation funeral, the <b>cremation fee</b> . <sup>2</sup> In this local area, the typical cost of a cremation for local residents is:	<b>£760 - £1060</b>

<b>ADDITIONAL FUNERAL DIRECTOR PRODUCTS AND SERVICES</b>	
This funeral director may be able to supply a range of optional, additional products and services, or to arrange (on your behalf) for a third party to supply them. Examples include:	
Additional mileage (price per mile)	<b>£2.00</b>
Additional transfers of the deceased person's body (e.g. to their home, to a place of worship etc.) (price per transfer)	<b>£295</b>
Collection and delivery of ashes	<b>Price on request</b>
Embalming	<b>£160</b>
Funeral officiant (e.g. celebrant, minister of religion etc.)	<b>From £230</b>
Services supplied outside of normal office hours	<b>Price on request</b>

The funeral director can give you a full list of what they can supply. They are likely to charge for these additional products and services, so you may choose to take care of some arrangements without their involvement, or you can use a different supplier.

<sup>1</sup> This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

<sup>2</sup> In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation

### TERMS OF BUSINESS

Our Terms of Business include the following:

### PAYMENT ARRANGEMENTS

The final funeral account is created on confirmation of funeral arrangements, and is due for payment within 30 days of the funeral taking place, unless otherwise agreed by us in writing.

### OVERDUE ACCOUNTS

£100 will be added to any outstanding balance, up until 30 days following the funeral invoice date and add a further £100 every 30 days thereafter to the outstanding balance.

Any invoice still outstanding after 60 days may be referred to a collection agency and will also be subject to a surcharge of 15% plus VAT to cover any collection costs incurred. This surcharge along with all other charges and legal fees incurred will be the responsibility of the customer and will be legally enforceable.

### INDEMNITY

You are to indemnify us in full and hold us harmless from all expenses and liabilities we may incur (directly or indirectly including financing costs and including legal costs on a full indemnity basis) following any breach by you of any of your obligations under these Terms. This means that you are liable to us for losses we incur because you do not comply with these Terms. For example, we will charge you an administration fee where we receive a cheque from you which is subsequently not honoured or if we have to write to remind you that an account is overdue. If we instruct debt collection agents, we may also recover from you the fees we incur. Further details regarding these fees are available on request. We claim those losses from you at any time and, if we have to take legal action, we will ask the Court to make you pay our legal costs.
